Request for Additional Appropriations for Personal Protective Equipment

Please accept this letter from the City of Franklin Fire Department for additional appropriations from the old Ambulance Fund 61 for the acquisition of Personal Protective Equipment. The amount of we are requesting is a \$75,280.00. The following explanation is given to guide our discussion for this request and we appreciate your consideration on this issue.

Problem Defined: During the last year we exhausted all options to develop a plan for a proper gear replacement matrix and acquisition plan. We defined our need, recognized the mistake of not purchasing adequate numbers in the last three years thus falling behind, due to budget constraints. We exhausted all options and alternate sources of funding. Federal assistance and grant research proved unfruitful and the management of the Assistance to Firefighters Grant System during the Federal Sequester and Shut Down stalled all attempts for help.

Research for pricing: We have looked at every cost saving measure. We have a bulk price from provided by the Johnson County Chiefs Association. This is accomplished by requesting to tie into the IFD competitive bid. We looked at online or other providers and could not find a better price, for gear meeting NFPA standards. Our current price for gear is approximately \$1,957.00 dollars. Online pricing is in excess of \$1,900.00 dollars but it does not have a personal fit, nor does it allow any assistance with options.

The Johnson County Specification Bid Price is \$1,820.00 with our full set of options. If we believe we need to be purchasing between 10 to 12 sets of gear per year, we have fallen drastically behind since 2011. The total numbers of gear we need to get caught up is 36. The total for the Fire Gear Request would be \$65,520.00.

*We have a limited window for pricing and 2014 costs will go up in February.

Gear Replacement Matrix: We have developed a workable plan for replacing gear in a timely fashion with a "first five" years of service as primary followed by a "second five" year plan to capture back up gear. We submit the matrix to you to consider. What we are asking for is to start this plan in motion with the additional funding support.

Water Rescue Gear: Throughout the course of training and preparation for the water rescue team we have learned that we cannot continue to share exposure suits. To use them in a temporary fashion for short term use is fine, but for comfort, support, and proper use, it must be a custom fit. We would like to finish the program by assigning individual suits. The total number of suits needed to finish outfitting the team is 16 suits at \$610.00 per suit. The total for this request is \$9,760.00.

We submit our current pricing and specifications for this equipment. We submit the Fire Gear Matrix for your consideration. We also open this up for discussion to ask for your assistance. The use of this funding will kick start a proper and long lasting matrix to properly outfit the men.
