Popular Event Makes Debut in Johnson County

Dancing with the Stars is coming to Johnson County. The events will take place at 7pm on September 26 and 27 at The Artcraft Theatre.

Eight county non –profits will participate in the first ever Dancing with the Johnson County Stars this fall. Each agency has selected a “celebrity” dancer to represent them on stage.

The eight agencies involved and their dancers are:

Franklin Heritage – dancer Stephanie Wagner, manager, PNC bank

Gateway Services/Access Johnson County – dancer, Joanne Cheek, Integration Manager for Ariba, an SAP Company

Interchurch Food Pantry – dancer Brent Corey, President, Sizemore Insurance Agency and member, Greenwood City Council

Johnson County Historical Society – dancer, Carla Taylor, Manager of the Emergency Dept, EMS, and Case Management/Utilization Review, Johnson Memorial Hospital

Johnson County Senior Services – dancer Rose Hyde. Rose is a community volunteer.

Kic-It – dancer, Rafael Sanchez, reporter, RTV6

The Refuge – dancer, Aaron Beasley, Elementary Director, Emmanuel Baptist Church

Youth Connections – dancer, Hon. K. Mark Loyd, Judge, Johnson Circuit Court

The agencies, their dancers and instructors from Arthur Murray Dance Studio, Greenwood, met a couple of months ago. Dancers were paired with instructors, photos were taken for publicity, and dance lessons were scheduled. Since then, most have begun their lessons and worked with a choreographer on the two dances they will perform.

Meanwhile, each of the agencies is contacting local businesses to sell sponsorships and ads in the program – and offering tickets in addition to the chance to be recognized as a supporter. The agencies are also busy planning fundraisers which will add to their total monies raised and the dancers will be raising money by seeking pledges from co-workers, friends and family. The public will be able to vote for their favorite dancer prior to the event or during the performance by going to www.wedoauctions.net/DWTJCS and texting a monetary amount. They can also go to the website, www.dancestar2.com, go to their favorite agency's website, and donate there.

The event was originally scheduled to take place on September 27. However, community response has been so great that a second performance has been added on September 26. Both events will take place at 7 pm at The Artcraft Theatre in Franklin.

The audiences will see each dancer perform two dances with their Arthur Murray instructor. Best Dancer recognition will be awarded on Friday and Saturday nights. However, the coveted "Mirrored Ball Award" will go to the dancer and agency who raises the most money. The goal for the event is to raise a total of \$100,000.

Judges for Saturday night will be Mayor Mark Meyers, City of Greenwood, Mayor Joe McGuinness, City of Franklin, Chris Cosner, Advertising Manager of the Daily Journal and Jackie Miller, community volunteer. Friday night's judges will be representatives of some of the sponsors. Rob Shilts, director of Franklin Heritage, will serve as MC for both events.

Wine will be available from Mallow Run winery and beer will be available from Taxman Brewery in Bargersville.

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
