RESOLUTION OF THE FRANKLIN BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AUTHORIZING THE LOCAL MATCH
COMMITMENT OF THE RAILROAD SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS APPLICATION TO THE INDIANAPOLIS
METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION AND ADDRESSING RELATED MATTERS

WHEREAS, the City of Franklin, Indiana recognizes the need to provide a safe transportation environment, stimulate growth and to maintain a sound economy within its corporate limits; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Franklin, Indiana has worked jointly with Johnson County, the City of Greenwood and the Town of Whiteland to provide said safe transportation environment with regard to the Louisville and Indiana Railroad.

WHEREAS, the City of Franklin, Indiana has discussed jointly and regularly with neighboring communities as representatives of the Louisville and Indiana Railroad regarding safety improvements to the rail.

WHEREAS, the City of Franklin, Indiana, Johnson County, the City of Greenwood, the Town of Whiteland and the Louisville and Indiana Railroad have tentatively agreed to share the cost of matching funds for such safety improvements.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Franklin Board of Public Works, Franklin, Indiana that:

The Franklin Board of Public Works hereby commits the requisite local funds in conjunction with those other entities noted above as matching funds for said program, such commitments to be contingent upon receipt of Federal Highway Funding from the Indianapolis Metropolitan Planning Organization.
