A Proclamation designating April as Fair Housing Month

- Whereas:** Attaining housing is a basic human right and decent housing creates and raises quality of life; and
- Whereas:** Ignoring the need for fair housing can perpetrate poverty, segregation and ignorance in our community; and
- Whereas:** The City of Franklin has a need to educate the community on fair housing and to inform the public of resources to combat housing discrimination; and
- Whereas:** We recognize that no one person can do everything, but that every person can do something and together we can create change for the betterment of our community; and
- Whereas:** in the month of April, we will all join together to encourage safe housing, and to educate the community on resources available to them in order to prevent housing discrimination before it occurs.
