**A RESOLUTION OF THE FRANKLIN BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY
RELATIVE TO THE SUPERVISION MANAGEMENT AND CONTROL OF
GREENLAWN CEMETERY**

WHEREAS, the City of Franklin, Indiana (“City”) previously operated Greenlawn Cemetery under the control and management of the Franklin Board of Public Works and Safety pursuant to Ordinance No. 92-2, which Ordinance was enacted in order to eliminate duplicating services, labor, and costs the City was incurring when the cemetery was managed by the former Franklin Board of Cemetery Regents.

WHEREAS, Ordinance 92-2 was repealed by the City and Ordinance 03-13 was enacted wherein the City delegated the day to day management control and operation of Greenlawn Cemetery to the Franklin Parks Board.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 06-07 repealed Ordinance No. 03-13 relative to the supervision, management and control of Greenlawn Cemetery and through the repeal of Ordinance No. 03-13, the supervision, management, and control of Greenlawn Cemetery was delegated to a separate City department and a department head under the direction and control of the Mayor.

WHEREAS, the City has identified the opportunity to realize additional efficiencies and benefits relative to personnel management and utilization costs, purchasing and other related activities by repealing Ordinance No. 06-07 and returning the control and management of Greenlawn Cemetery to the Franklin Parks Board through delegation from the Franklin Board of Public Works as previously delegated under Ordinance 03-13.

WHEREAS, the Franklin Board of Public Works and Safety supports the repeal of Ordinance No. 06-07 by the City of Franklin Common Council and further recognizes the benefit of once again delegating the control and operation of Greenlawn Cemetery to the Franklin Parks Board.

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Franklin Board of Public Works and Safety recommends approval of the City Ordinance repealing Ordinance No. 06-07 and further resolves that after repeal of said Ordinance to delegate the day to day management, control and operation of Greenlawn Cemetery from the Franklin Board of Public Works and Safety and Safety to the Franklin Parks Board.
