Chief O'Sullivan,

On November 29, 2012, Lieutenant Hinkle and I visited Elmore's Firearms and Accessories located at 520 North State Road 135, Suite I, Greenwood, Indiana 46142. Elmore's Firearms and Accessories agreed to purchase a Franklin Police Department pistol. The pistol was a green Glock 22, .40 caliber pistol, with serial number ELC775 and two 15 capacity magazines.
