Request for Increased House count to be Reflected in Waste/Recycling Collection Payment

Ray's Trash Service, Inc. would like to formally request that the house count for the City of Franklin be increased by 58 homes and reflected in payment. The current house count of 7158 is invoiced at \$9.16 per home for a total of = \$65567.28 per month. The new invoice will reflect a house count of 7185 homes invoiced at \$9.16 per home for a total of - \$65814.60 per month. The 27 homes was a reconciliation of new construction since the beginning of the agreement (January 2012) based on new water/sewer connections from Sherry Phillips, City of Franklin on January 15, 2012. Rick Littleton has received this information and is aware that the contractor (Ray's) is requesting this amount to be paid in months going forward, as well as for the January 2012 invoice to be retroactive per this request. SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT SERVICES


December 9, 2011




