Mayor Barnett stated that they had a meeting with County Commissioner Baird, three different downtown businesses, the Parks Department, Fire Department & Police Department concerning downtown festivals downtown. Ms. Delph stated this request lists all streets that will need to be closed for all Discover Downtown Franklin (DDF) events for 2017, and that two events have been modified due to the meeting mentioned by the mayor. Mayor Barnett made a motion to approve, seconded by Mr. Swinehamer. A voice vote was taken with all members stating aye. The motion carried.

Request Use of City Parking Lot, Monroe & Water Streets, May 25th through May 29th and September 28th through October 2, 2017 for Franklin Lions Club Fish Fry - John M. White came forward to explain this request. Mr. White stated this was to request approval to use the city parking lot on the corner of Monroe and Water Street for the Lions Club annual Fish Frys. City Attorney Gray told Mr. White that he would need to fill out an Indemnification & Hold Harmless Agreement, and have a Certificate of Insurance on file with the City. A discussion was held. Mr. Swinehamer made a motion to approve with the conditions listed by Ms. Gray, seconded by Mayor Barnett. A voice vote was taken with all members stating aye. The motion carried.

Mr. Swinehamer made a motion to approve, seconded by Ms. Jones. A voice vote was taken with all members stating aye. The motion carried.

Request Approval of Auction Agreement with Hughes Auctions – Mayor Barnett explained this was a contract to hire Hughes Auction to handle our city surplus auction in May. Mayor Barnett made a motion to approve, seconded by Mr. Swinehamer. A voice vote was taken with all members stating aye. The motion carried.

Request Approval of Contract and Signing of Contract from Impact Networking, LLC for Copier/Printer - Fire Chief Dan McElyea stated this is to get approval to purchase a new copier/printer, and him signing the contract. Mayor Barnett made a motion to approve, seconded by Ms. Jones. A voice vote was taken with all members stating aye. The motion carried.

Carisa Delph of DDF stated that the Farmers Market starts May 6th, and will run through Sept. 2, 2017.

City Engineer Mark Richards stated that the South Main Street Bridge has been torn out, and reconstruction will be starting soon.
