3.16.1 PURPOSE

This procedure establishes a policy and procedure for accessing Franklin Community School (FCS) buildings and facilities during emergency response.

3.16.2 POLICY

The Franklin Police Department and Franklin Community Schools have established an emergency response entry plan that will assist law enforcement officers during emergency response. This plan shall not be shared with media personnel and/or persons outside of the police department. Indiana Code 5-14-3-4(b)(18) Access to Public Records, exempts disclosure of school safety and security measures, plans, and systems, including emergency preparedness plans.

3.16.3 PROCEDURE

Department personnel shall follow the FCS Emergency Response Entry Plan on file.
