ORDINANCE NUMBER 20-11 OF THE CITY OF FRANKLIN, INDIANA

An Ordinance Repealing Ordinance Number 97-36 Creating An Insurance Trust Fund

WHEREAS, the Clerk Treasurer of the City of Franklin, Indiana, with approval of the City Common Council did request the creation of an Insurance Trust Fund for the purpose of maintaining funds for use in unusual, emergency, or extraordinary situations to fund unexpected insurance claims as set forth by Ordinance Number 97-36; and

WHEREAS, at the time of adoption of Ordinance Number 97-36 the Clerk Treasurer of the City of Franklin, Indiana; the Common Council and Mayor did create such general fund to address potential needs considered at said time; and

WHEREAS, the current Clerk Treasurer of the City of Franklin, Indiana; the Mayor and Common Council deem that the need for such separate Insurance Trust Fund no longer exists and that the purpose of said fund was originally intended to address is now more appropriately funded through the City's existing general fund accounts; and

WHEREAS, the Insurance Trust Fund known as Funds 712 currently has a balance in said account of \$548,588.38 as of the 31st day of July, 2020 which the Clerk Treasurer, Mayor and Common Council deem should be returned to the City's Group Insurance Account Fund #713.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRANKLIN, INDIANA, DOES FIND, ORDAIN AND AUTHORIZE THE FOLLOWING:

- 1. Ordinance Number 97-36 of the City of Franklin, Indiana creating an Insurance Trust Fund and all other Ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are no longer in force or effect, and are now hereby repealed;
- 2. The Clerk Treasurer of the City of Franklin, Indiana is authorized to close the Insurance Trust Fund known as Fund 712 and transfer all sums of money in said Fund to the Group Insurance Account Fund #713 of the City of Franklin, Fund Number #713.
- Construction of Clause Headings. The clause headings appearing in this
 Ordinance have been provided for convenience and reference, and do not purport
 and will not be deemed to define, limit or extend the scope or intent of the clauses
 to which the headings pertain;
- 4. Severability of Provisions. If any part of this Ordinance is held to be invalid, such part will be deemed severable and its invalidity will have no effect upon the remaining provisions of this Ordinance;

ORDINANCE NUMBER 97-36 OF THE CITY OF FRANKLIN, INDIANA

AN ORDINANCE CREATING AN INSURANCE TRUST FUND

WHEREAS, the Clerk-Treasurer of the City of Franklin, Indiana has determined that the City does not have an appropriate general fund account to maintain funds for use in unusual, emergency, or extraordinary situations, and said official recommends that the Common Council and the Mayor authorize and create a new general fund account to be referred to as the "Insurance Trust Fund" for that purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRANKLIN, INDIANA, ORDAINS AND ENACTS THE FOLLOWING:

- 1) A new general fund account, to be referred to as the "Insurance Trust Fund", is created for use by the Clerk-Treasurer as said official deems necessary and appropriate in order for the City to maintain runds in unusual, emergency, or extraordinary situations.
- 2) Construction of Clause Headings. The clause headings appearing in this ordinance have been provided for convenience and reference, and do not purport and will not be deemed to define, limit, or extend the scope or intent of the clauses to which the headings pertain;
- 3) Repeal of Conflicting Ordinances. The provisions of all other ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are of no further force or effect, and are now repealed;
- 4) Severability of Provisions. If any part of this ordinance is held to be invalid, such part will be deemed severable and its invalidity will have no effect upon the remaining provisions of this ordinance;
- Duration and Effective Date. The provisions set forth in this ordinance become and will remain in full force and effect (until their repeal by ordinance) on day of the passage and adoption of this ordinance by signature of the executive in the manner prescribed by Indiana Code § 36-4-6-15. 16.

Introduced and Filed on the 2 day of 1991. A motion to consider same on the First Reading or day of introduction was [not offered] [sustained by a vote of 1 in Favor and 1 Opposed, pursuant to Indiana Code § 36-4-6-13.]
