Dear Mayor Barnett,

The Franklin Lions Club respectfully requests the use of the south half of the city parking lot at the northeast corner of Monroe and Water Street in downtown Franklin for our spring fish fry on May 21, 2021. For several reasons, including but not limited to a dwindling, and aging membership, we have been forced to rethink the way we conduct our spring fundraising event. Rather than a two-day fish fry, as conducted in the past, we have decided to conduct a scaled down one-day event, with serving hours limited to 4:00 pm to 8:00 pm on Friday, May 21, 2021.
