Subject: Approval of purchase of banner hardware for Jefferson Street

The Public Art Advisory Commission met December 8, 2022 and approved banner designs for the Bicentennial that will go on King Street, South Main Street and Jefferson Street. The new banners will required hardware for the Jefferson Street section, which will run from Walnut Street to Yandes Street and consists of 30 poles. A portion of this street is the parade route, which the Bicentennial parade will run in September. This also includes an additional 5 poles on King Street to complete that section. These poles were not initially included in the first set of banners, as there were construction issues and a pole was not in place at the time.

The cost for the brackets is \$194 each with an estimated freight cost of \$238. This is the same price as the brackets purchased last year and will complete the poles in the downtown and gateway. The total cost is estimated to be \$7,028. There was only one vendor who can match the current poles and supply the brackets in a timely fashion.

The Public Arts Advisory Commission will purchase the banners for these poles.
