CODE § 36-8-3.5-12, the Franklin Police Merit Commission has, over the last three months, conducted a competitive process to develop an applicant eligibility list for new Merit Officers. #### RESOLUTION CERTIFYING APPLICANT ELIGIBILITY LIST

WHEREAS, Indiana Code § 36-8-3.5-12(e) and (f) require Police Merit Commissions to create and maintain biennial lists of eligible applicants for appointment as Merit Police Officers (hereinafter "Applicant Eligibility Lists") and to certify those lists to the safety board of their respective municipalities as they are created, and;

WHEREAS, the safety board of the City of Franklin is the Franklin Board of Public Works and Safety, and;
