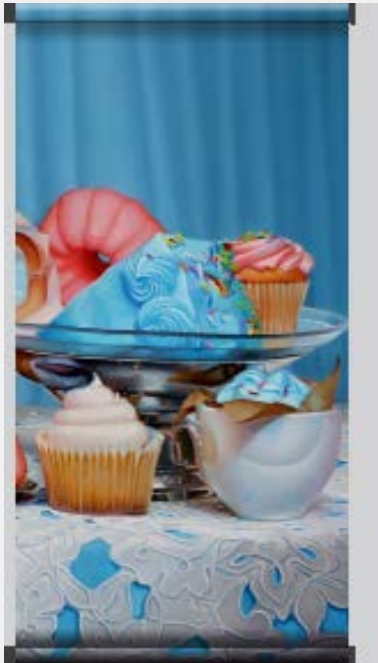


WALNUT ST TO WATER ST

opportunities, and both benefited and given back to the community when I have the ability. My

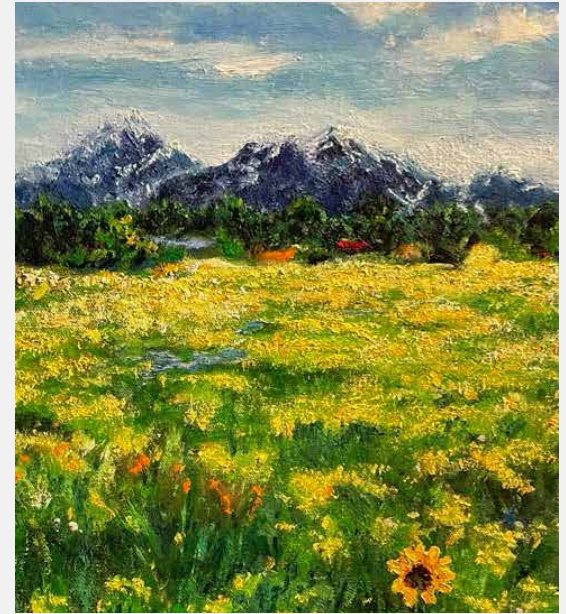
Career as an Artist has been built and fed by the support of friends and family in Franklin, it was
