Re: Cases C 2024-20: Innovative 3D Manufacturing (2021-17)

Summary:

1. On April 19, 2021, the Franklin Common Council passed Resolution No. 2021-19, approving a 5-year tax abatement with a 5% economic development fee on personal property for the real estate located at 600 International Drive.

2. Actual and estimated benefits, as projected for 2023:

- 3. Innovative 3D Manufacturing indicated they would add one employee in 2021. The company has added two employees. The hourly salaries are slightly below due to new employee skill level, which will improve. In 2022 the wages appear lower as some of the employees were part-time for several months while training was taking place. In 2023 all the employees are full time and wages are above estimates.
- 4. The personal property investment meets the SB-1 estimate.
- **5.** The personal property abatement will expire in 2027 and be paid in 2028 with final compliance in 2027.
