Checklist for Residential Building Permit Applications

All building permit applications must include the following items:

- A site plan, drawn to scale, including the following information:
 - 1. The dimensions of the lot
 - 2. The names and right-of-way width of all adjacent streets and alleys
 - 3. All easements and required building setback lines
 - 4. All existing and proposed utilities
 - 5. All existing buildings on the property with dimensions
 - 6. The zoning of the property
 - 7. All the land and floor elevations
 - 8. The lot number and subdivision or legal description
 - 9. Sidewalk placement and width
 - 10. Street tree placement, size and specie
 - 11. A north arrow
- One set of constructions drawings including the following information:
 - 1. A foundation plan
 - 2. A floor plan
 - 3. Building elevations
 - 4. An electrical plan (layout, service size and location)
 - 5. A plumbing plan (fixture placement, hot water heater, lateral location)
 - 6. An HVAC plan
 - 7. A wall section detail showing all materials
 - 8. A roof framing detail (pitch, materials, spans, and layout)

(Note: All engineered products must be documented and certified with an Indiana Registered Engineer stamp)

Please note that at the time the permit is obtained the permit fee, sewer tap-on fee and park impact fee (if applicable) are to be paid to the City of Franklin at the Planning & Engineering Department. Three separate checks are required.
