A BUDGETARY ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES OF APPOINTED OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF FRANKLIN, INDIANA FOR YEAR 2005.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRANKLIN:

Section 1

That for the year 2005, the annual salary and pay for the appointed officers and employees of the City of Franklin, Indiana, be fixed as follows:

Section 2

The payroll week shall be the calendar week beginning Saturday and ending Friday. The payroll period shall consist of two (2) consecutive weeks. Unless otherwise determined by the Department Head, the hourly rate for non-exempt full-time civilian employees is to be calculated by dividing the biweekly salary by the number of hours in two regularly scheduled workweeks for such employee.

Section 3

- Benefit time and special leave compensation for civilian employees is pursuant to Ordinance 02-04.
- b) Benefit time and special leave for merit police officers is pursuant to the Franklin Police Department Rules and Regulations Manual approved by Board of Public Works and Safety on January 10, 1995.
- c) Benefit time and special leave available to merit fire fighters is pursuant to the Fire Department Rules and Regulations Manual approved by Board of Public Works and Safety on April 9, 2002 pursuant to Resolution 02-02.
- d) Pursuant to Ordinance No. 02-04, employees that are called in to work on a holiday will be compensated at 1.5 times their regular rate of pay in addition to holiday pay for all hours worked. This section does not apply to sworn police officers, police patrol dispatchers, and sworn fire fighters.
- e) Longevity pay is pursuant to Ordinance No. 02-10.
- f) Clothing allowances will be paid to designated employees at the following rate according to Ordinance No. 04-12:
 - (I) Merit Police Officers, Police Evidence Technicians and Merit Fire Fighters \$800/yr.
 - (II) Police Dispatchers \$400/yr.

Section 4

The benefits above-stated are for reference and illustration only, and their inclusion in this ordinance does not modify the specific benefit provided by other Ordinances.

Section 5

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and signing by the Mayor.
