## ORDINANCE NUMBER 10-10 OF THE CITY OF FRANKLIN, INDIANA

## AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING FUNERAL BENEFITS AMOUNT FOR 1925 POLICE PENSION FUND

WHEREAS, Indiana Code § 36-8-6-9.8 authorizes the payment of funeral benefits to the heirs or estate of an active or a retired member of the police department covered under the 1925 Police Pension Fund who has died from any cause;

WHEREAS, the 1925 Fund shall be used for to pay for funeral benefits in an amount established by ordinance, but at least twelve thousand dollars (\$12,000);

Now, Therefore, The Common Council of the City of Franklin, Indiana, Ordains and Enacts the following:

- 1) **Establishment of Funeral Benefits Amount**. The 1925 fund shall be used to pay funeral benefits to the heirs or estate of an active or a retired member of the police department who has died from any cause in the amount of twelve thousand dollars (\$12,000).
- 2) Construction of Clause Headings. The clause headings appearing in this ordinance have been provided for convenience and reference, and do not purport and will not be deemed to define, limit, or extend the scope or intent of the clauses to which the headings pertain;
- 3) **Repeal of Conflicting Ordinances.** The provisions of all other ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are of no further force or effect, and are now repealed;
- 4) Severability of Provisions. If any part of this ordinance is held to be invalid, such part will be deemed severable and its invalidity will have no effect upon the remaining provisions of this ordinance;
- Duration and Effective Date. The provisions set forth in this ordinance become and will remain in full force and effect (until their repeal by ordinance) on day of the passage and adoption of this ordinance by signature of the executive in the manner prescribed by Indiana Code § 36-4-6-15, 16.

Introduced and Filed on the <u>2</u> day of <u>angust</u>, 2010. A motion to consider same on the First Reading or day of introduction was [not offered] [sustained by a vote of 7 in Favor and 0 Opposed, pursuant to Indiana Code § 36-4-6-13.]
