A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPLICATION SUBMISSION AND LOCAL MATCH COMMITMENT

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRANKLIN, INDIANA AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF THE CDBG PLANNING GRANT APPLICATION TO THE INDIANA OFFICE OF COMMUNITY AND RURAL AFFAIRS AND ADDRESSING RELATED MATTERS.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Franklin, Indiana recognizes the need to stimulate growth and to maintain a sound economy within its corporate limits; and

WHEREAS, the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, authorizes the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs to provide grants to local units of government to meet the housing and community development needs of low-and moderate-income persons; and

WHEREAS, the City of Franklin, Indiana has conducted or will conduct public hearings prior to the submission of an application to the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs, said public hearings to assess the housing, public facilities and economic needs of its low-and moderate-income residents;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRANKLIN, INDIANA, THAT:

- The Mayor is authorized to prepare and submit an application for grant funding to address
 downtown revitalization and to execute and administer a resultant grant including requisite
 general administration and project management, contracts and agreements pursuant to
 regulations of the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs and the United States
 Department of Housing and Urban Development.
- The City of Franklin, Indiana hereby commits the requisite local funds in the amount of five thousand and five hundred dollars (\$5,500) provided by the Franklin Development Corporation, as matching funds for said program, such commitment to contingent upon receipt of CDBG funding from the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs.
