NEW BUSINESS

A Petition for Four Way Stop at Jason Avenue and Maria Avenue. – Mrs. Jennifer Gabbard of 4023 Jason Avenue appears to request the installation of a 4 way stop in her neighborhood. She gave the Board a petition signed by her and 33 other residents of the area supporting the request. The Board asked Mr. Weir to consider the request and make a recommendation at the next meeting. Tabled until September 25, 2001.

A Petition to Close Madison Street between the Willard Restaurant and the Office Building to the North on (approx. 45 Feet) October 5th from 3:00 p.m. until 8:00 a.m. the following day. – Mr. Bob Schofield, proprietor of the Willard appears to make this request. Mr. Ault made a motion to approve the request with the following provisions: The street will be closed from 3:00 p.m. on October 5 until 8:00 a.m. October 6th; the tent will be approximately 20 X 15 and will be staked from curb to curb (no stakes will be driven into the street), they will provide security according to the recommendations of the Chief of Police, there will also be a barrier surrounding the area with a single entrance; and the City will be named as an additionally insured on the liability policy for this event, Mr. Hougland seconded this motion. Motion carried.

Mr. Fred Paris Requests for Tree Removal – Mr. Paris asked that specific trees on Forsythe St. & Grizzly Drive be trimmed back and requested that the City approve and effect the removal of trees on South St. from south of the railroad tracks to the Library. Mr. Paris has reached an agreement with the homeowner to concerning the trees. The Board tabled this matter until next meeting. September 25, 2001.
