BUDGETARY ORDINANCE NO.: 12-09

A BUDGETARY ORDINANCE FIXING THE ANNUAL SALARIES AND PROVIDING COMPENSATION FOR ALL ELECTED OFFICIALS OF THE CITY OF FRANKLIN, INDIANA FOR YEAR 2013 AMENDED AFTER INTRODUCTION

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Franklin, Indiana, has previously determined the salaries of the elected officials of the City for the year 2013 should now be fixed by the Common Council of the City of Franklin.

BE IT ESTABLISHED AND ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Franklin, Indiana, that:

Section 1

The salaries of the said elected officials of the City of Franklin, Indiana for the year 2013 payable from the specified funds of the City shall be as follows:

Section 2

The Officials of the City of Franklin, Indiana, both elected and appointed employees of said City who perform services for the City, other than governmental, whose services are connected with the operation of any municipally owned utility or function, may receive additional compensation for said services, and said additional compensation shall be determined and fixed by the administrative authority in control of the operation of such utility or function, subject to the approval of the Mayor and the Common Council; provided further, that any additional compensation so authorized shall be paid from the revenue derived from the operation of such utility or function. If an elected official should want to donate his or her salary, or a portion of it, back to the City, he or she may do so, minus the taxes they would have to pay on the

Section 3

This Ordinance shall repeal Budgetary Ordinance No. 11-05 entitled, <u>"An Ordinance Fixing The Annual Salaries And Providing Compensation For All Elected Officials And Providing For The Publication Thereof, City Of Franklin"</u> and become effective at the commencement of the terms of such officers on January 1, 2013.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval according to law.
