Budgetary Ordinance 11-09 Additional Appropriation – Cemetery Trust Fund

Cemetery Sexton Richard DeWitt was present to answer questions. Mr. Ault made a motion to approve, seconded by Mr. Hougland. A voice vote was taken with all members stating Aye. Ordinance 11-07 – Regulating Door to Door Solicitation

City Attorney Rob H. Schafstall stated that the proposed ordinance includes a \$50.00 fee to anyone receiving a solicitation permit and criminal record checks. Mr. Abban made a motion to read the ordinance by title only, seconded by Mr. Ault. The motion carried, and Dr. Murphy read the title aloud. Dr. Murphy asked for public comments. Mr. Joe Class asked what exactly this ordinance covered. Mr. Schafstall explained the ordinance in detail. A discussion was held. Mr. Austin made a motion to approve, seconded by Mr. Ault. A voice vote was taken with all members stating Aye. No members stating Nay. The motion carried.

Ordinance 11-08 – An Ordinance Approving Vacating Right-of-Way Within The City of Franklin, Indiana Between Lots 49 & 50 of John Herriott's North Addition

Senior Planner Joanna Myers came forward and explained that the alley is no longer used. Mr. Austin made a motion to read by title only, seconded by Mr. Abban. Dr. Murphy read the title aloud. A discussion was held. Dr. Murphy stated that this is a public hearing and asked if anyone from the public had any comments. No one asked to speak. Mr. Austin made a motion to approve, seconded by Mr. Ault. A voice vote was taken with all members stating Aye. No members stating Nay. The motion carried.
