

RESOLUTION NO.: 14-03
OF THE CITY OF FRANKLIN BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY
Authorizing the Transfer of Surplus Property

WHEREAS, IC 5-22 ("Purchasing Statute") permits a purchasing agency to adopt policies to supplement IC 5-22 or a rule adopted by the Council, so long as the policies are not inconsistent with the Purchasing Statute or a rule adopted by the Council; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Franklin has previously designated the Board of Public Works and Safety as a purchasing agency; and

WHEREAS, IC 5-22-22-3 permits the purchasing agency to sell property that is no longer needed or is unfit for the purpose for which it was intended and has been declared surplus; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Public Works and Safety as the purchasing agency for the City of Franklin; has determined that surplus property more specifically identified as:

Snapper Riding Mower, Stihl Hand-Held Blower, & Century Battery Charger purchased and used by the Franklin Parks and Recreation Department is deemed surplus; and


WHEREAS, the City of Franklin Street Department wishes to acquire these items for their use;

WHEREAS, IC 5-22-22-3 and IC 36-1-11-8 requires that resolutions be adopted before the transfer or exchange of governmental property


This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption.


