## A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL, FRANKLIN, INDIANA, TO SUPPORT THE SUBMISSION OF THE COALITION APPLICATION FOR EPA BROWNFIELDS ASSESSMENT GRANT FUNDING

WHEREAS, the City of Franklin has determined that it should be proactive in the restoration of environmentally impaired sites to productive and beneficial use; and

WHEREAS, the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) provides grants to communities for the assessment of environmentally contaminated properties; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that a unified administrative/legislative effort would be advantageous to the City of Franklin when pursuing EPA brownfield assessment funding;

WHEREAS, the grant will be a cooperative effort between a "Coalition" of communities and include the City of Franklin, the City of Greenwood, and the Town of Whiteland, with the City of Greenwood serving as the grant recipient and administrator;

WHEREAS, upon award of the grant, the City of Franklin understands that the Coalition members will finalize a binding Memorandum of Agreement to document the allocation of grant funds, administrative and programmatic tasks for the grant project, site selection process, and Coalition member responsibilities among others.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of Franklin, Indiana as follows:

Section 1. The City of Franklin, Indiana supports the application to the EPA for the EPA Brownfield Assessment Grant to fund environmental assessment activities at Brownfield sites in the City of Franklin.

Section 2. This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption by the City Council.
