## **ORDINANCE NUMBER 15-12**

## OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRANKLIN, INDIANA AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE BENEFIT PAID TO THE SURVIVING SPOUSES OF DECEASED MEMBERS OF THE 1925 POLICE PENSION FUND AND THE 1937 FIRE FIGHTERS PENSION FUND

WHEREAS, Indiana Code 36-8-6 and Indiana Code 36-8-7 indicate that the primary basis for benefit calculations for members of the 1925 Police Pension fund and 1937 Firefighters Pension fund; who did not convert to the 1977 plan; is the salary of a first class patrolman plus longevity for the 1925 plan; and the salary of a first class firefighter plus longevity for the 1937 plan, and

WHEREAS, Indiana Codes 36-8-6 and 36-8-7 provide instructions for arriving at the minimum amount to be paid to each surviving spouse. Indiana Code statutes allow for additional amounts to be paid to surviving spouses on the condition that the additional amounts are approved by ordinance, and

WHEREAS, both the Fire Pension Board and the Police Pension Board of the City of Franklin have a policy that provides that retirees or their surviving spouses would receive raises when City employees received raises, and

WHEREAS, this policy was formerly applied in the course of the annual budget process without the benefit of a specific enabling ordinance.

## Now, Therefore, The Common Council of the City of Franklin, Indiana, Ordains and Enacts the following:

- 1. The City Clerk Treasurer is hereby authorized to increase the benefit paid to surviving spouses of deceased members of the 1925 Police Pension Fund and the 1937 Fire Fighters Pension Fund equal to the average percentage raises afforded to full time employees;
- 2. **Construction of Clause Headings**. The clause headings appearing in this ordinance have been provided for convenience and reference, and do not purport and will not be deemed to define, limit, or extend the scope or intent of the clauses to which the headings pertain;
- 3. **Repeal of Conflicting Ordinances**. The provisions of all other ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are of no further force or effect, and are now repealed;
- 4. **Severability of Provisions**. If any part of this ordinance is held to be invalid, such part will be deemed severable and its invalidity will have no effect upon the remaining provisions of this ordinance;
- 5. **Duration and Effective Date**. The provisions set forth in this ordinance become and will remain in full force and effect (until their repeal by ordinance) on day of the passage and adoption of this ordinance by signature of the executive in the manner prescribed by Indiana Code §§ 6-4-6-15, 16, retroactive to January 1, 2014.
