**RESOLUTION OF THE FRANKLIN COMMON COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF THE
RAILROAD SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS APPLICATION TO THE INDIANAPOLIS METROPOLITAN
PLANNING ORGANIZATION AND ADDRESSING RELATED MATTERS**

WHEREAS, the City of Franklin, Indiana recognizes the need to provide a safe transportation environment, stimulate growth and to maintain a sound economy within its corporate limits; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Franklin, Indiana has worked jointly with Johnson County, the City of Greenwood and the Town of Whiteland to provide said safe transportation environment with regard to the Louisville and Indiana Railroad.

WHEREAS, the City of Franklin, Indiana has discussed jointly and regularly with neighboring communities as representatives of the Louisville and Indiana Railroad regarding safety improvements to the rail.

WHEREAS, the City of Franklin, Indiana, Johnson County, the City of Greenwood, the Town of Whiteland and the Louisville and Indiana Railroad have tentatively agreed to share the cost of matching funds for such safety improvements.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Franklin City Council, Franklin, Indiana that:

The Mayor is authorized to prepare and submit an application for grant funding to address railroad safety improvements within the City of Franklin, and to execute and administer a resultant grant including requisite general administration and project management, contracts and agreements pursuant to regulations of the Indianapolis Metropolitan Planning Organization, Indiana Department of Transportation and Federal Highway Administration.
