

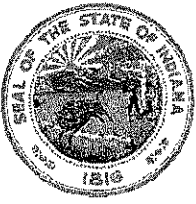

Through Operation Pullover (OPO), the Indiana Criminal Justice Institute provides funding to law enforcement subgrantees to conduct overtime traffic enforcement patrols. The primary focus of these patrols has been to increase seat belt compliance and reduce impaired driving crashes, injuries and deaths. As part of these OPO patrols, law enforcement subgrantees are also encouraged to engage in speed enforcement.
