Request Approval to Saw Cut Asphalt City Street Resurfaced Less Than 5 Years Ago at 731 Graham Street and Approval of 2 day Street Closure of Graham Street between Robinson Street and Howe A Street

Dane Waltman, works with Fisher Contracting. Mr. Waltman is requesting to cut an asphalt street that is less than 5 years old. They need to connect in the middle of the road for sanitary connections. The builder needs to coordinate with all the utility company for one street cut and road closure. Mr. Swinehamer made a motion to approve subject to coordinating with the City Engineer and other utility companies to be cut and closed for the shortest time period possible and repair completed with surface before asphalt companies shut down, seconded by Ms. Jones. A voice vote was taken with all members stating aye. The motion carried.

Clerk Treasurer, Jayne Rhoades request street closure of Martin Place for residents Amy Heavilin and Jack Wood. A voice vote was taken with all members stating aye. The motion carried.

Request Approval of Change Order 1, East Court Street Alley Improvement Project - City Engineer, Mark Richards

City Engineer, Mark Richards request a change order#1 in the amount of \$5,800.00 for concrete removal in the alleyway. The new contract amount is \$106,970.00. Ms. Jones made a motion to approve, seconded by Mr. Swinehamer. A voice vote was taken with all members stating aye. The motion carried.

Request Approval of Professional Services Agreement for the City Court Addition at the Street Department Building - City Engineer, Mark Richards

City Engineer, Mark Richards request approval of scope and fee proposal only from Cripe for the City Court addition in the amount of \$61,900.00. No contract ready and would be subject to funding. A discussion was held. Anticipated cost of the entire project would be \$500,000.00 with the scope and fee proposal included in the amount. Mr. Swinehamer made a motion to approve, seconded by Ms. Jones. A voice vote was taken with all members stating aye. The motion carried.
