#### Consent Agenda

Mayor Barnett presented the consent agenda for approval.

o Approval of the March 4, 2019 Common Council Minutes

Council President Austin made a motion to approve the consent agenda as presented, seconded by Councilor Abban. A voice vote was taken with all members stating aye. The motion carried.

Common Council Budgetary Ordinance No.: 19-03 A Budgetary Ordinance Repealing & Replacing Budgetary Ordinance No.: 18-09 Fixing & Authorizing the Payment of Certain Salaries of Appointed Officers & Employees of the City of Franklin for Year 2019 (Sewer Utility) - Mayor Barnett stated this was introduced at the previous meeting, this is for the salary for Interim DPW Superintendent Sally Brown. Mayor opened the floor for public hearing, no one asked to speak. Council President Austin made a motion to approve, seconded by Councilor Abban. A voice vote was taken with all members stating aye. The motion carried.

Common Council Ordinance No.: 19-01 Small Wireless Facilities Design Requirements & Permitting - City Attorney Lynn Gray stated in January there was a mandate for municipalities concerning small wireless facilities. Ms. Gray stated we have until April to come up with guidelines for these facilities. Senior Planner Joanna Myers stated the following guidelines are listed in this ordinance: Purpose & Compliance; Application Requirements; Aesthetic Requirements for Small Wireless Facilities; Location Requirements; Construction Requirements; Permitting Process; Enforcement & Definitions. A discussion was held. Councilor Eggers made a motion to approve on first reading, seconded by Councilor Abban. A voice vote was taken with all members stating aye. The motion carried. Mayor Barnett opened the floor for public hearing, no one asked to speak. Councilor Eggers made a motion to approve, seconded by Councilor Richards. A roll call vote was taken with Councilors Abban, Austin, Eggers, Heuchan, Richards, & Wertz stating aye, & Councilor Blankenship stating nay. The motion carried 6-1.
