**A RESOLUTION TO OPT OUT OF OPIOID SETTLEMENT
PURSUANT TO INDIANA CODE 4-6-15-2**

WHEREAS, the City of Franklin, by and through its Board of Public Works and Safety has previously retained counsel for purposes of addressing the Opioid epidemic that has adversely impacted the residents of the City of Franklin;

WHEREAS, the City of Franklin Board of Public Works and Safety has been advised of a settlement negotiated by the Indiana Attorney General; and

WHEREAS, the City of Franklin, having considered whether to elect to opt out of the Opioids Settlement under I.C. 4-6-15-2, does hereby resolve as follows:

1. That the City of Franklin, by and through Board of Public Works and Safety now exercises its election to opt out of the Opioid Settlement pursuant to I.C. 4-6-15-2.
2. The Board of Public Works and Safety further orders its duly authorized agent to submit a certified copy of this Resolution to the Indiana Attorney General by June 30th, 2021.
