RE: Proposal for Art District Banner Designs

Hello!

Thank you for the opportunity to propose my ideas for the Art District banner project. I am a life-long Franklin resident and currently live near downtown. These banners are some of my favorite art installations around.

I am applying today for my artwork to be considered for the new round of banners for two reasons. The first is personal. I love my town and would love nothing more for my life's passion to be included in the display and promotion of the art district. Secondly, stained glass, which is the primary medium in which I work, would make lovely and striking banners with its bold colors and structured design.

As a concept, I have pulled together 10 examples of ways to use pictures of my past glass work in banner design. There are a few issues because glass is notoriously hard to photograph, BUT, if chosen, I have some ways of making these designs stunning.

Some of the designs are sections of stained glass windows I have constructed. I like these for banners because Franklin has many churches, homes, and buildings with stained glass.

Other designs include stained glass suncatchers displayed in an artistic way. See the butterfly and crows as good examples. The crows are part of my Sill Sitter line of stained glass birds that I sell here in Franklin. They are familiar to many residents. I often incorporate old, broken jewelry and findings into my glasswork as you can see in a couple of the suncatcher pieces.

One note is that this has been a busy pre-holiday season for me, so I was a little bit hurried pulling these examples together. If you think these may work, I have several other options to choose from, or would definitely work to make the colors a teeny bit brighter on the pieces I have included. I have 12 years worth of work to choose from, so I am not overly attached to any if you would like to see more.






