

Sewer Maintenance Operator/Laborer

The DPW is accepting applications for the position of Sewer Maintenance Operator/Laborer. The Collections department is responsible for keeping the collection system running smoothly by accomplishing the items below. This position must be filled by an individual who has their CDL.

Job Duties:

- Must locate sewers and sewer lines for maintenance and construction.
- Must check lift stations daily to ensure pumps are running properly.
- Must assist in maintaining and repairing all equipment found to be defective.
- Must perform inspections of laterals for new construction and repairs throughout the community.
- Must be able to operate pipeline inspection equipment to trouble shoot sewer line problems.
- Must locate manholes throughout the City.
- Must maintain and repair the holding tank at the Fairgrounds.
- Must maintain sewer equipment and trucks by performing normal maintenance and minor repairs.

Education and Experience:

Preference will be given to applicants with previous experience working in an equal or similar capacity. The applicant must have a high school diploma /education, a valid driver's license and a CDL.

The incumbent will be required to work overtime, weekends and holidays and respond to operational emergencies 24/7 as needed. Both indoor and outdoor work may be required in all weather.

Uniforms will be provided.
