REQUEST FOR BIDS

The City of Franklin, Indiana will receive bids for the Franklin Acquisition Project - Demolition Phase, all in accordance with the Contract Documents. Bids will be received until **8:45 a.m. EST on August 2, 2011**, at the Office of the Clerk-Treasurer, City of Franklin, 70 East Monroe Street, P.O. Box 280, Franklin, Indiana 46131, at which time all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. Bids received after that time will be returned unopened. Bids will be received at the Office of the Clerk-Treasurer during normal business hours 8:00 am to 4:00 pm, local time.

The project will consist of the demolition, utility abandonment, site restoration, and asbestos & environmental abatement, if necessary, of residential houses. The contractor will be required to separate and track certain demolition materials for recycle/reuse. This includes but is not limited to: dry wood, concrete, and shingles. **Only pre-qualified Contractors will be allowed to submit bids for this Project.**

The Proposal must be made on the forms provided in the Contract Documents.

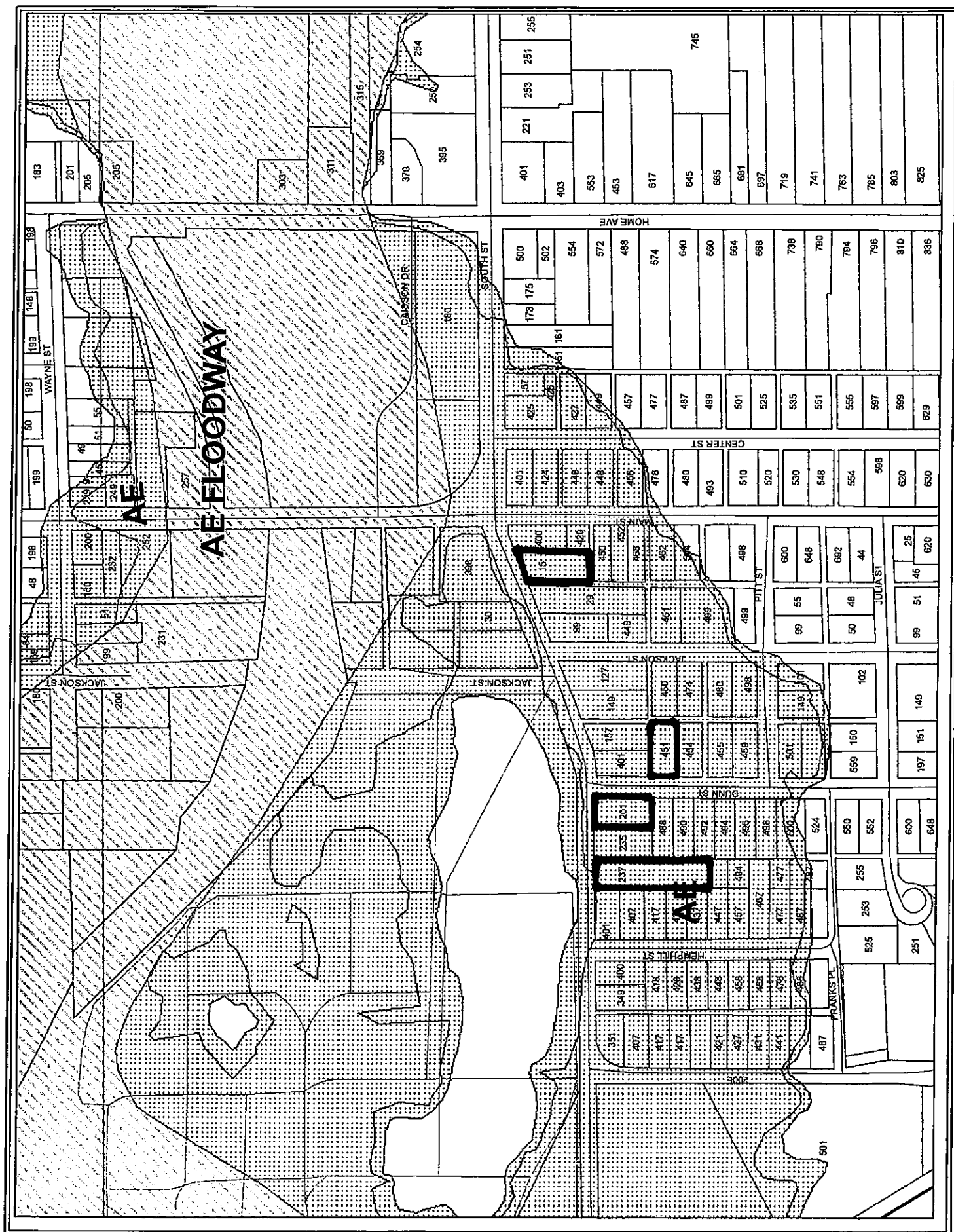

Bids may be held by the City of Franklin, Indiana, for a period not to exceed sixty (60) days from the date of the opening of the bids for the purpose of reviewing the bids and the investigation of the qualifications of bidders, prior to awarding of the Contract. It is anticipated, however, that the contract will be awarded on or after August 2, 2011.
