

Vicki, This is a tough thing to deal with, it is a concern in all the new large additions. First of all I can and will send someone out from both the Police Dept and Code Enforcement to review. That said with the limited amount of street parking in all additions, taking parking off of curbs where it was originally planned for in the development plan just causes more problems along the remaining parking areas just to each end of the curb. We are reviewing potential ideas of such ideas as limiting street parking to maximum 3 hours during day times (most likely won't get enough support.) To at least passing an ordinance that has all cars off the street certain days of the month for maintenance which would at least get junk cars moved often enough to encourage people to get rid of them or park them in their own drives.
