The City of Franklin, Indiana ("City"), by and through its Street Department, desires to provide to the above-named property owner ("Owner") a program for the planting of public trees on private property which adjoins a public right-of-way where space or other limitations do not otherwise permit planting, and said Owner agrees to cooperate in and abide by the provisions contained herein.

- 1) The City will select acceptable tree species, number of trees, and planting locations (to be noted above).
- 2) The City will plant such tree(s) and will maintain proper sidewalk clearance thereunder.
- 3) The City will pay the full cost of such trees, unless said trees are also provided in connection with the City's Cooperative Planting Program, in which event the City and Owner will pay their respective and proportionate cost of said trees as provided in that program.
- 4) The Owner authorizes the City's agents and employees to enter said property for the purpose of said planting and maintenance for the sidewalk clearance.
- 5) The Owner holds the City harmless from any and all damages to persons and/or property that might occur as the result of any such planting and/or maintenance.
- 6) The Owner agrees to provide any and all of the maintenance required for such trees, except proper sidewalk/street clearance, including the watering thereof during the first critical year.
