ORDINANCE NUMBER 12-06 OF THE CITY OF FRANKLIN, INDIANA

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY'S DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY RELATIVE TO GREENLAWN CEMETERY TO THE FRANKLIN PARKS BOARD AND REPEALING ALL PRIOR ORDINANCES RELATING THERETO

WHEREAS, the City of Franklin, Indiana ("City") previously operated Greenlawn Cemetery under the control and management of the Franklin Board of Public Works and Safety pursuant to Ordinance No. 92-2, which Ordinance was enacted in order to eliminate duplicating services, labor, and costs the City was incurring when the cemetery was managed by the former Franklin Board of Cemetery Regents.

WHEREAS, Ordinance 92-2 was repealed by the City and Ordinance 03-13 was enacted wherein the City delegated the day to day management control and operation of Greenlawn Cemetery to the Franklin Parks Board.

WHEREAS, Ordinance Number 06-07 repealed Ordinance Number 03-13 relative to the supervision, management and control of Greenlawn Cemetery and through the repeal of Ordinance Number 03-13, the supervision, management, and control of Greenlawn Cemetery was delegated to a separate City department and a department head under the direction and control of the Mayor.

WHEREAS, the City has identified the opportunity to realize additional efficiencies and benefits relative to personnel management and utilization costs, purchasing and other related activities by repealing Ordinance Number 06-07 and returning the control and management of Greenlawn Cemetery to the Franklin Parks Board through delegation from the Franklin Board of Public Works as previously delegated under Ordinance 03-13.

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Franklin, Indiana recognizes the benefits repealing the prior ordinances would have in favor of once again delegating the control and operation of Greenlawn Cemetery to the Franklin Parks Board.

WHEREAS, the Franklin Board of Public Works and the Franklin Parks Board have each also recognized the benefits that such delegation would offer, and the Common Council of the City of Franklin concur. This Ordinance is enacted by the Common Council in order to memorialize its consent to the proposed delegation of control.

Now, Therefore, The Common Council of the City of Franklin, Indiana, Ordains and Enacts the Following:

- 1) Repeal of Ordinance Number 06-07. Ordinance Number 06-07, which provided that the supervision, management and control of Greenlawn Cemetery would be performed through a separate City department and a department head (Sexton) appointed under the direction of the Mayor is hereby repealed.
- 2) Approval of Delegation of Greenlawn Cemetery. By repeal of Ordinance Number 06-07, the day to day management, control and operation of Greenlawn Cemetery reverts to the Franklin Board of Public Works and Safety. By enactment of this Ordinance, the proposed delegation of the day-to-day management, control and operation of Greenlawn Cemetery from the Franklin Board of Public Works and Safety to the Franklin Parks Board is approved. In order to effectuate this delegation in a manner most likely to realize all the envisioned benefits, the Common Council authorizes the recharacterization of expenses relative to Greenlawn Cemetery for budgetary purposes, when such a re-characterization is necessary and proper, and the Clerk Treasurer is directed and authorized to assist in that re-characterization as needed.
- 3) Construction of Clause Headings. The clause headings appearing in this Ordinance have been provided for convenience and reference and do not purport and will not be deemed to define, limit, or extend the scope or intent of the clauses to which the headings pertain.
- 4) Repeal of Conflicting Ordinances. The provisions and all other Ordinances in conflict with the provision of this Ordinance are of no further force or effect, and are now repealed.
- 5) Severability of Provisions. If any part of this Ordinance is held to be invalid, such part will be deemed severable and its invalidity will have no effect on the remaining provisions of this Ordinance.
- 6) **Duration and Effective Date.** The provisions set forth in this Ordinance become and will remain in full force and effect (until their repeal by Ordinance) on the day of the passage and adoption of this Ordinance by signature of the executive in the manner prescribed by Indiana Code § 36-4-6-15, 16.


RESOLUTION OF THE FRANKLIN PARKS BOARD
