Re: Awarding of the Meritorious Conduct Medal

Evidence Technician Davis:

I am pleased to inform you that you have been awarded the Meritorious Conduct Medal for your efforts in securing evidence to identify a suspect for a business burglary and bank robberies.

On April 12, 2012 you processed a burglary scene at Shelby Materials located at 451 Arvin Drive, Franklin. Shoeprints, broken glass and several areas of a red substance resembling blood were found. In addition to photographs and fingerprints, swabs were taken of the blood-like substances. On May 04, 2012 the items with elimination fingerprints were sent to the Indiana State Police Laboratory for analysis. On May 23, 2012 the results for the DNA analysis on the swabs were posted. On June 06, 2012 A CODIS hit was received linking the DNA found at the scene with the convicted offender Tobie Dennis, and on June 18, 2012 the final DNA report was posted naming Dennis as the source of the DNA. Incident number 12040559F.

On April 20, 2012 you processed the scene of a bank robbery, First National Bank. You were able to collect several fingerprints and swabs were taken off the countertop for possible touch-DNA. A recovered vehicle was also processed. On May 04, 2012 the collected fingerprints and swabs from the robbery scene and recovered truck, and the print cards of Tobie Dennis were submitted to the Indiana State Police Laboratory for analysis. On May 23, 2012 the results for the DNA analysis on the swabs were posted. Also posted were the results of the fingerprint analysis identifying one print from the robbery scene and one print from the vehicle as belonging to Tobie Dennis. Incident number 12041007F.

Evidence Technician Davis, as a result of your diligent work habits, attention to detail and overall professionalism, Tobie Dennis was identified as the responsible person for the Shelby Materials burglary, the Franklin bank robbery, as well as being responsible for the bank robbery in Trafalgar.

The example you have set is a credit to you and the Franklin Police Department. Great work!
