Re: Case C 2013-38: CTC Casting Technologies

#### Summary:

1. On January 17<sup>th</sup>, 2012, the Franklin Common Council passed Resolution Number 2012-02, approving a 7-year tax abatement on personal property for CTC Casting Technologies, Inc. located at 1450 Musicland Drive.

2. Actual and estimated benefits, as projected for 2012:

- 3. As noted in a letter from Chuck Schiavello, Controller for CTC Casting, two abatements were voluntarily rescinded (Resolution Number 2007-08 and Resolution Number 2008-11), and were replaced with Resolution Number 2012-02.
- 4. The company has greatly exceeded the number of new employees and the average hourly salaries for all employees are slightly higher than estimated.
- 5. The company has exceeded their estimate for personal property investment.
- 6. The personal property tax abatement is scheduled to expire in tax year 2018 payable 2019. The final compliance review will take place in 2019.

Enclosed, please find Form CF-1/PP (Compliance with Statement of Benefits) regarding compliance with the personal property tax abatements which were granted to CTC in 2012 under Franklin Common Council Resolution number 12-02. Please note that CTC is not filing any compliance paperwork for Resolution numbers 08-11 and 07-08 as those abatements were voluntarily rescinded by CTC upon issuance of abatement 12-02.

As indicated on the attached documents, our company has exceeded the capital investment projections for this project. Project spending to date of \$2.135 million is approximately \$800,000 higher than the projected spending of \$1.350 million.

CTC was also successful in exceeding head count projections. In addition to retaining our 57 existing employees, we were able to add 47 new employees in 2012. The increase of 47 employees exceeds our projected increase by 22 employees and brings our total head count to 104.
