On behalf of our client, Rexam Consumer Plastics, Inc., we are requesting a Waiver of Non-Compliance for the Personal Property abatements associated with Resolution # 2010-05 and Resolution # 2012-08. Bald Eagle Consulting Inc. files the Personal Property returns for this facility. The abatements were handled by the plant personnel. A lack of communication between the two resulted in the Personal Property returns being filed without attaching the abatements for the tax years ending March 1, 2011 and March 1, 2012. After discussing the matter with Ms. Sandy Pendleton, Personal Property Manager, Johnson County IN Assessor's Office, Rexam will need the Waiver of Non-Compliance in order for her to correct and amend the two returns in question.
