Call to Order

Ken Kosky called the meeting to order at 8:00 a.m.

Roll Call & Determination of Quorum

Approval of Minutes

October 9, 2025 Meeting Minutes – There is a change to the meeting minutes from October. Ms. Noblitt, not Ms. Robertson, made a motion to adjourn the meeting, and Mr. Causey, not Mr. Windisch, seconded. Mr. Causey made a motion to approve the meeting minutes with the change, seconded by Mr. Hendrickson. Passed unanimously, 7-0.

Committee Reports

Community Art Committee: Ken Kosky – The committee is looking at a proposal for what they can do on the other side of the Veterans' Alley and the costs. They are also discussing the walking tour site still. Dana added that the City's Attorney has some concerns with the contract, so this is still being worked through, and more to come. They are still moving forward with preparing content and getting tours ready while working through the contract. Mr. Causey added that there is a chance this may have to "live" under a different non-profit just due to the language of the proposed contract. Krista Linke, Director of Community Development for the City, came up and spoke that this was discussed at the FDC meeting the previous day. The FDC put the amount in their budget for 2026 and approved the amount for the walking tour site for next year. Also, if the FDC needs to be the owner of the app, that can likely happen. The committee is also working on funding for the art for the water tower. There is a possibility of a grant from Eli Lilly. Indiana American Water has already given permission to paint the water tower.

Programming Committee: Josh Hendrickson — The deadline has been extended for submissions for the banners that will be displayed along East and West Court Street and North and South Main Street.



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There are a few new submissions from this, and they can be reviewed at the next committee meeting. They are continuing to work with the Parks & Recreation Department on their programs and art for those.
